

Job Announcement

Center for the Advancement of Higher Education, TOHOKU UNIVERSITY, seeks applicants for two positions of Instructor in Teaching of English. The appointed candidates are expected to teach general and practical English courses in General Education Program. All qualified applicants are encouraged to apply. Tohoku University is committed to promotion of gender equality.

Position: Instructor, Center for the Advancement of Higher Education.

Type of Job: Nontenure-track position. Initial contract is for 4 years, and renewable only once. The renewed contract is for 3 years.

Number of Positions: 2

Salary: The university's pay scale is applied.

Teaching Load: Eight 90-minute English classes per week.

Research Field: Teaching of English

Requirements:

- (1) Master's Degree, Ph.D., or its equivalent is required
- (2) Diploma of TESOL or TEFL is preferred
- (3) Experience of English teaching at the college level is required.
- (4) Native speaker of English is required.
- (5) High-level Japanese language proficiency is preferred.

Starting Date: April 1, 2014.

Application Materials: Candidates should submit the following set of documents:

- (1) A Curriculum Vitae (with education, employment history and a photo)
- (2) A list of academic publications, and reprints of three main papers in the list.
- (3) A written statement of your philosophy and approach to teaching English at Japanese universities (not more than 2 pages either in Japanese or in English)
- (4) Two letters of recommendation
