TOHOKU UNIVERSITY works to strengthen the Global Leadership Program and foster and promote globalized human resources. Institute for Excellence in Higher Education, Center for Culture and Language Education, TOHOKU UNIVERSITY seeks candidates to teach German courses as described below. The appointed candidates are expected to teach general and practical German courses in the General Education Program. Tohoku University is committed to the promotion of gender equality.

1. Department: Institute for Excellence in Higher Education, Center for Culture and Language Education. (Address: 41 Kawauchi, Aoba-ku, Sendai City, Miyagi Prefecture)
2. Position: One Senior Assistant Professor (Lecturer)
3. Research Field: German Education
4. Job Responsibility: Teaching German courses and developing German educational programs at the University level
  - 1) Eight 90 minutes' German classes per week
  - 2) Development of a German educational program
  - 3) Additional work in the Center for Culture and Language Education
5. Qualifications:
  - 1) Ph.D. or its equivalent is required
  - 2) Experience in teaching German at the university level
  - 3) Other: Native speaker of German (without regard to country of origin)  
High level Japanese language proficiency is preferred  
An eagerness to take a leadership role in university language education
6. Term of position: Initial contract is for 5 years. During the first five years, based on an evaluation of performance, a tenured position is possible. If a tenured position is deemed not possible at that time, the contract may be renewed for an additional three years, after which a final evaluation will be made to determine if a tenured position is possible.
7. Salary: Tohoku University's pay scale is applied.
8. Starting Date: On or about April 1, 2017

  - 2) A list of educational and academic achievements

  - 4) A summary of your research and educational activities (not more than 2 pages in Japanese)
